

## Call for applications: Erasmus Plus scholarships to study at Ludwig-Maximilians-Universität (LMU) during the spring semester of 2017-2018

The European Union is offering 5 scholarships for undergraduate and graduate students to study at LMU within the Erasmus Plus Program. Detailed information is available in the table below.

Requirements	<ol> <li>Registered student at TAU</li> <li>Minimum average of 80</li> <li>Fluent English or German – the minimum required English level is B2.</li> <li>Students from all fields but Medicine and Pharmacy and all cycles (bachelor, master, PhD)</li> <li>Bachelor's and master's student can only participate in the program from the 1<sup>st</sup> semester of the second year of studies until the 1<sup>st</sup> semester of the last year of studies.</li> <li>PhD students can arrive to LMU for a shorter period than 5 months (the minimum period is 3 months). Since PhD students do not have to take courses, they can also arrive to LMU during the summer for example, and not necessarily during the semester dates, as long as their supervisor is present at LMU during their stay. Please note that housing in a student dormitory is only possible for the</li> </ol>
	entire semester and for students under the age of 29.
Scholarship details	800 Euros per month for a duration of 5 months. Travel expenses on the amount of 360 EURO.
Number of required credits	Bachelor's and master's students are recommended to take at least 20 ECTS credits (equivalent to 10 TAU credits) in order to be eligible for the Erasmus+ Scholarship. Also read the LMU information in the link above.
